

#### Badges


All delegates and guests will receive a name badge at the Welcome desk. Please wear your badge at all times.

The Guinness Enterprise Centre is 1km (14 minute walk/5 min cab ride) from St. James Hospital Luas (Tramstop), 1.3 km (19 minute walk/8 min cab ride) from Heuston Station and 2.4 km (30 minute walk/15 min cab ride) from Dublin City Centre. Take the number 123 Bus from O'Connell Street or Dame Street (direction Walkinstown) and disembark at James Street Bus Stop 1940. It's the first stop after Arthurs Pub opposite ROE & CO. On street parking is available a couple of minutes from the GEC, be mindful of the one way system in the area.

#### Accommodation

We recommend delegates stay in the local area the night before the event, to make it easier to arrive at the venue for a 9am start. Hotels are available nearby to suit a range of budgets.
